ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT
RE: Liquidzymes

We have reviewed the composition of *Liquidzymes* and assessed the products with regard to their aquatic toxicity and environmental impact.

The individual constituents of *Liquidzymes* have inherently very low aquatic and mammalian toxicity and the organic constituents are readily biodegradable as per Australian Standard AS 4351.

The estimated acute aquatic toxicity of *Liquidzymes* (Rainbow Trout LC₅₀ (96h) >100mg/L) is such that the product is **not** classified, as "Dangerous for the Environment" according to the criteria of European Commission Dangerous Substance Directive 79/831 and the product label does not require any additional risk statements.

As a matter of good product stewardship, neither the product nor the used containers should be allowed to come into contact with natural waterways. In the event of a major spill, every effort should be made to prevent spilled material from entering natural waterways by damming with earth, sand or other absorbent material. The spilled material should be re-used or disposed of at an approved landfill site in accordance with local regulations.

In the event of a minor spill or wash-down after cleaning up a major spill entering natural waterways, the product is not likely to cause any short term or long-term adverse environmental effects since dilution and biodegradation will rapidly take place.
