



# Bird Ban Gel

## Surface treatment to deter roosting and nesting

Non-acidic, non-toxic long-lasting weather-resistant gel dries clear and near-invisible. Does not harm birds; its tacky consistency makes birds feel uncomfortable, discourages roosting and nesting, preventing acidic droppings from damaging and contaminating property. Use wherever birds are a menace or health hazard: outdoor cafes, food courts, building facades, ledges, roof beams, sills. Coverage: 2-3 sq m per litre.

## Directions for use:

**Dilution:** Do not dilute.

### Initial application:

1. Clean the surface to be treated, removing bird dropping build-up.
2. Ensure surface is dry before applying.
3. Apply a thin layer using a putty knife or similar to level surfaces whose temperature will not exceed 40°C. Avoid applying the product within 10 mm of the edge.
4. Clean up with a solvent cleaner.

### Reapplication:

As this product is extremely tacky it will collect dust and other debris from the environment. This contamination can reduce its effectiveness over time.

1. Use a putty knife or similar to scrape off the contaminated product.
2. Use a solvent cleaner to remove any product that has spread into the 10 mm edge area.
3. Reapply the product as for an initial application.

**Note:** The product may be used on mildly sloping surfaces and in areas where surface temperatures may exceed 40°C, however there is a risk of some unwanted spreading.
